



Edmonds Library Quick Statistics

- In 2016, 246,000 people went to the library out of a service population of 40, 706.
- Built in 1982, it is owned by City of Edmonds. 18K sqft building.
- 28 public PC computers offering 70 pages of free printing weekly, free wifi and we're open 63 hours a week.
- ipads with educational software for preschoolers.
- We offer laptop(s) for public use to use anywhere in the library.
- There are 25 full time and part time employees.



Edmonds Community Library Statistics

- ~76K items housed at Edmonds as part of entire library system's shared collection.
- 392,525 items checked out in 2016.
- 352 programs from babies and toddlers to Music at the Library, writing classes, Seattle Opera to tax aide supported by AARP 2016.
- Total program attendance—10, 274.




